

**MEMORANDUM FOR SHORT-TERM STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAMS
DESIGNATED FOR SPECIAL PURPOSES**

between

**COLLEGE OF HUMANITIES AND SOCIAL SCIENCES,
NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF KAOHSIUNG,
TAIWAN**

and

**FACULTY OF CULTURE AND INFORMATION SCIENCE,
DOSHISHA UNIVERSITY,
JAPAN**

College of Humanities and Social Sciences, National University of Kaohsiung (NUK, hereafter) and Faculty of Culture and Information Science, Doshisha University (DU), recognizing the value of international cooperation, hereby agree upon the following terms and conditions for Short-term Student Exchange Programs Designated for Special Purposes, based upon the spirit of the Agreement for the Exchange of Students.

1. NUMBER AND STATUS OF STUDENTS

Within any one week of one academic year, up to five (5) students from each institution may be exchanged as non-degree students at the other institution. Students participating in this program will continue as candidates for the degrees of their home institution.

2. SELECTION OF PARTICIPANTS

The program is open to graduate students of each institution. Undergraduate students may also participate at the discretion of the host institution. Participating students will be selected by the home institution generally on the basis of academic merit. It is understood that the host institution reserves the right to make a final decision on the acceptance of students nominated for the student exchange program. In case the candidate should be rejected by the host institution for any reason, the home institution may nominate alternative candidates for consideration by the host institution on condition that such alternative applications could be made early enough for the host institution to arrange visa and other procedures in time for their proposed period of acceptance.

Students participating in the program may be required to display sufficient proficiency in the language appropriate to the host institution to carry out their studies and research at the host institution.

3. RESPONSIBILITIES

Each participating student will enjoy the same rights and privileges as students at the host institution and be subject to the regulations and discipline of the host institution and country. The institutions will provide each other with adequate information on the performance of participating students and each institution will nominate a member of staff to coordinate the program.

4. PROGRAM EXPENSES

The individual students participating in the program must pay for the travel expenses, including the air fare, to and from the host institution, visa, medical insurance and subsistence costs.

5. REPRESENTATIVES


NUK designates Professor Jyh-Wen Chern, and DU designates Professor Nobuyuki Yamauchi, as their respective officers responsible for the implementation of this Memorandum.


6. TERM OF VALIDITY, RENEWAL, AMENDMENT, AND TERMINATION

This Memorandum shall commence on the date when the representatives of both institutions affix their signatures and shall continue thereafter for five (5) years subject to revision or modification by mutual agreement. Either institution may, by notice in writing of no less than six (6) months, terminate this Memorandum, but any participating students who have commenced at either institution, or whose exchange procedures have been started by the date of termination, may complete their program. The institutions will confer concerning the renewal of this Memorandum six (6) months prior to its expiration.
